

In three of the Gospels, an event is described in which Jesus Himself was challenged by the leading Sadducees, who rejected belief in the resurrection. Jesus

countered their denials with an affirmation of resurrection (Mark 12:18-27); Matthew 22:23-33; Luke 20:27-40), saying "You are quite wrong!" (Mark 12:27).

In John 5:29 Christ taught that "those who have done good, (will come) to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of judgment. Elsewhere He declared, «I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live" (John 11:25).
