The Church of Saint Paraskevi at Geroskipou village in Pafos, Cyprus

The church of Saint Paraskevi lies 3,5 Km east of Pafos in Geroskipou village, which is probably a first of its kind creation of the byzantine architecture in Cyprus.

It is a three aisled arched basilica with five domes. Three of the biggest domes, are situated on top of the middle aisle and the other two on top of the left and right aisles next to the central dome. The position of the domes gives the chapel the shape of the cross. However, the church gives the impression of a basilica internally since the arches which divide the three aisles hide the domes of the side aisles. [read more... \(περισσότερα...\)](#)
