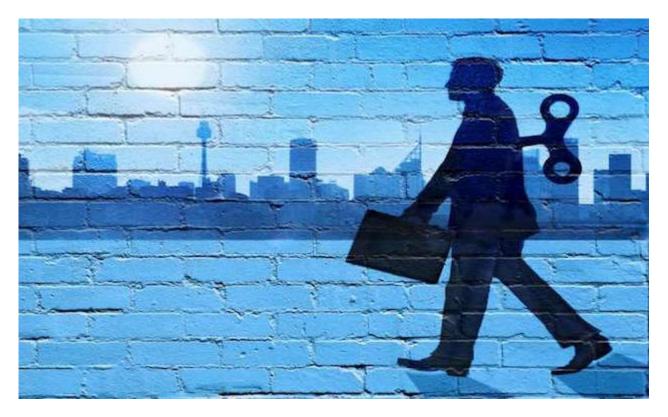
No better than animals (Saint Nectarios of Pentapolis)
