Even so, his parents Hadjiloukas and Lourdanou, who were God-respecting and devoted persons, made sure to give their child a Christian upbringing and they send him to study theology. When Polydoros grew up, he was naturally intelligent and creative and for this reason, he got started in the trade business.

For his work, he began to travel in various parts of the world including Egypt. For a

time, he followed the advices of his parents, and was careful about who he made friends with and their voices echoed permanently in his ears and restrained him from getting into bad company. However with time his attention became weak.
